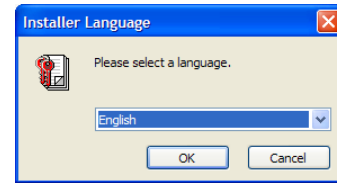


How to... **INSTALL AXCRIPT SOFTWARE**

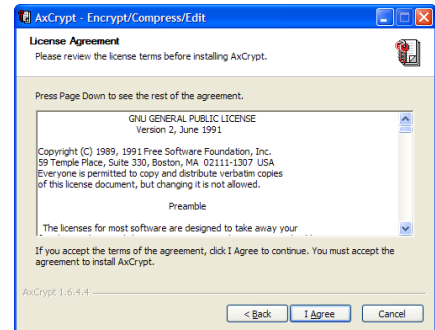

Download the AxCrypt installation file. Save the file onto a location on your computer. *(In order to install correctly, the user account installing the program must have Administrator rights on the local machine.)*

Double-click the installation file. The first action of installation is selecting the language that the program should use for communication. Select the appropriate language, and then click "OK".

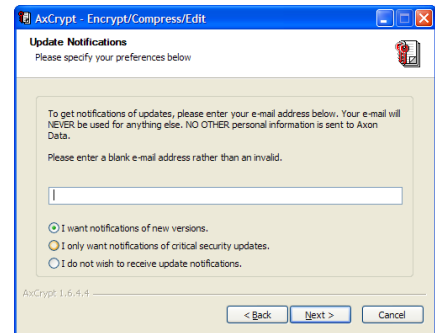


The AxCrypt license agreement will display. Review the agreement. If you agree to the Terms & Conditions of the agreement, select "I Agree". If you do not agree to the Terms & Conditions, select "Cancel" to quit installation.

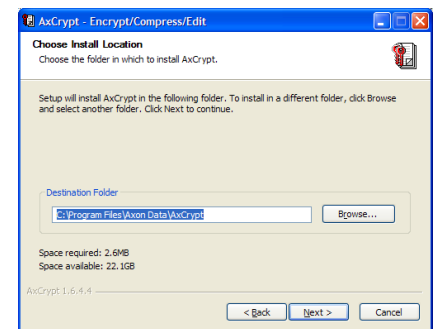


The AxCrypt Update Notification box will display. Installation does NOT require any information to be entered. However, if you would like to receive updates or other news regarding the program, you are welcome to supply your email address and choose the appropriate selection on information you would like to receive.

When complete, click "Next".



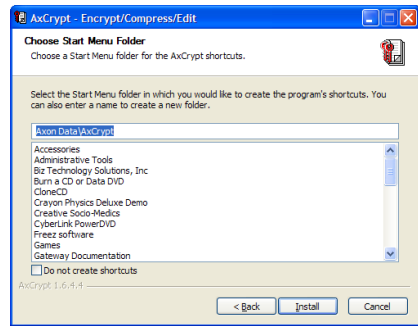
The AxCrypt Installation Location box will display. It is recommended that the program be installed in the default location. Click "Next" to proceed.



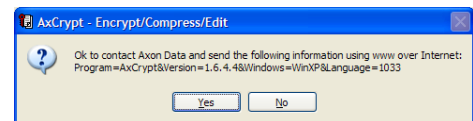

The AxCrypt Start Menu Folder dialog box will display. It is recommended that the default location be allowed. Click “Install”.

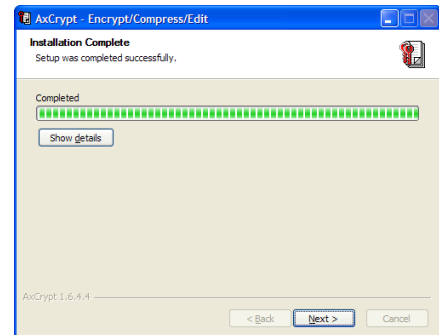


AxCrypt will install. After installation, a dialog box will appear asking for permission to send via internet connection information regarding the installation. (*Being open-source, the information is useful for program designers to track current user totals and versions. Submitting the information does not send private user data.*)



Choose “Yes” or “No” to proceed.

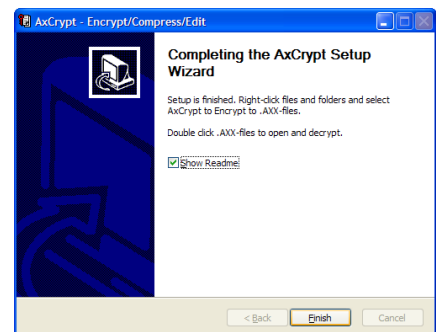
The AxCrypt Installation Complete box will appear. Click “Next” to continue.



After installation, the option to view the README file is available. If you would like to read the file (which contains information regarding proper encryption practices and advice on security), click “Finish”, and the file will automatically display.

To skip viewing of the README file, uncheck the proper checkbox and then click “Finish”.

Installation of AxCrypt is complete.
